It is quite clear that the actions of criminals are not representative of a religion nor is that religion to be held accountable.



The bombing at Oklahoma City by Timothy McVeigh and the killings that occurred at Ibrahim Mosque in Hebron by Dr. Baruch Goldstein clearly contradict the teachings of Christianity and Judaism, respectively. To wrongly associate religions with terrorism is in itself an act of terrorism, since it only incites hate and violence.

The association of Islam with terrorism and the hate crimes committed against innocent American muslims deserve the highest form of condemnation.

Why? Allah, Almighty God, said: "O mankind, an example is presented, so listen to it. Indeed, those you invoke besides Allah will never create a fly, even if they gathered together for that purpose. And if the fly should steal from them a thing, they could not recover it from it. Weak are the pursuer and pursued." [Quran 22:73]

This verse demonstrates the limited humble capabilities of man. It only exhibits the great dependency we have for our survival. We are a minute form of existence in our planet, which is only a small part of the solar system, which is only a small part of the milky way galaxy, which is only a small part of the virgo super cluster, which is only a small part of the cosmic horizon that we know. And for a surety, we know that the universe does not end there.

Our dependency makes us realize that there must be One who is Eternal and not dependent on anything— otherwise logically nothing would ever exist.

This Eternal Being, Power, Almighty Creator is therefore the only One who is worthy and deserving of all of our recognition, acknowledgment, praise, and worship.

Now, the manner of this worship should only be in a way that is pleasing to the Creator.

He alone has the Divine right to affirm or negate any manner of worship. It can not be subjected to the worshipper's whims and wishful thinking, otherwise that would only necessitate the acceptance of contradictory variations.

We make no distinction between any of them, and we are Muslims (those who submitted and surrendered to Allah-God Almighty) to Him. ' " [Quran 2:136]

The last and final Messenger was the Prophet Muhammad who came over fourteen hundred years ago with the final revelation of the Creator for mankind— the Quran.

It is this unique manner of worship, prescribed in Islam, with its serenity, tranquility, and monotheistic nature, that has caught the hearts of many and has made Islam the fastest growing religion in America and Europe.

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Worship In Islam

“And your Lord has decreed that you not worship except Him, and to parents, good treatment.” [Quran 17:23]

“And who is better in religion than one who submits himself to Allah while being a doer of good and follows the religion of Abraham, inclining towards truth? And Allah took Abraham as an intimate friend.” [Quran 4:125]


Despite the existence of stereotypes, bias, and misinformation about Islam, the worship of Allah (God Almighty) in Islam has attracted many, such that it is the fastest growing religion in the world today. What is its concept of worship?

Islam ordains the worship of Allah (God Almighty) without any polytheistic practices. None is to be worshipped or is deserving of any amount of worship except Him.

Now, worship in Islam is not just rituals that are practiced on a particular day only. The definition of worship in Islam is *any act or saying that is pleasing to Allah (God Almighty) and what is pleasing to Him is only known by the latest sent revelation*. Under this definition, a smile is regarded as worship and charity.

Many non-muslims’ misunderstanding about Islam stems from their secular definition of worship. As we can see, worship in Islam is comprehensive and a way of life. Therefore, a muslim woman covering, a muslim praying, a muslim seeking knowledge are all considered acts of worship because they are pleasing to Allah (God Almighty).

There are no popes, priests, saints or intermediaries between a man and his Lord in Islam. Every muslim enjoys a direct relationship with Allah (God Almighty) and worships Him directly.



In Islam, there is only one Divine that exists. Allah (God Almighty) is unique; there is none like or equal unto Him. This necessitates that He has no father or mother or son. There are no family of gods. Ascribing a mother or son to God would only bring about multiple divinities, and that would be polytheism— the greatest sin of all.

Our purpose in this life is to worship only Allah (God Almighty). We are accountable for what we do in this life; will we worship Him? Will we follow His latest sent revelation— the Quran? We must bear in mind that every choice and decision is subject to liability and responsibility on the Day of Judgment. Rejecting Allah’s (God Almighty) latest sent revelation is tantamount to rejecting Him.

Covering (Hijab) Is Freedom
